In the Classroom

In Science this term, K/1/2 have been learning how everyday materials can be physically changed in a variety of ways. At the end of the unit, students applied this new knowledge in a stem project.

Students are imagining that they are furniture designers who only work with newspaper. They must design and create a chair that can hold the weight of a small bear (baby bears chair is broken from Goldilocks).

Students must bend, twist, fold, scrunch, weave or change the newspaper in some way to make the chair. Lots of problem solving was used in their creations.
