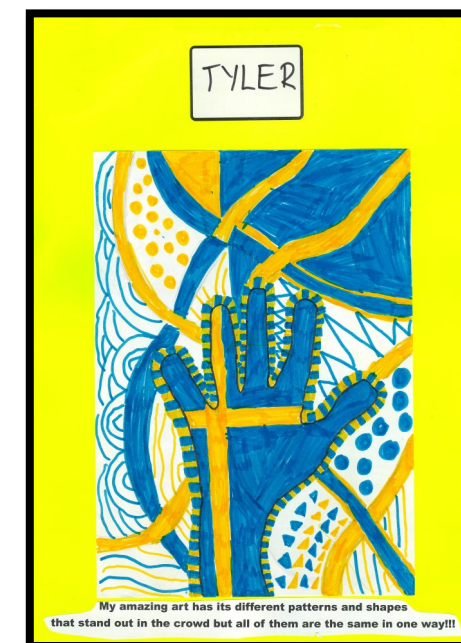

K-1, 2—K-1,2 have had a busy couple of weeks developing a better understanding of number word problems. The students have been learning to use Newman prompts and discussing the different strategies that could be used to solve the mathematical problem. The students have been identifying and comprehending what the word question is asking and then working through the steps of using diagrams and mathematical sums to find the answer. Students are being encouraged to share with the class the strategies used to determine the answer. In English the focus has been on the students learning to identify and use common and proper nouns in sentence structures. We are also continuing to think creatively and explore many different fairy tales. Over the next couple of weeks the students will be working in groups to create their own puppet show based around a fairy tale. The students are enjoying creating the back drops and thinking about how they will design their characters and writing their scripts to present their scene to the class.

Year 3 & 4



Year 5 & 6—Stage 3 has specifically been focusing on exploring ways in which we can 'tighten tension' within our writing. This includes using verbal and written descriptive language as well as escalating our writing with complications of a pebble, rock and boulder before concluding with exciting endings that have impact. Examples of students imaginative writing is displayed on the windows of the Year 5 & 6 classroom.

We have also been busy designing products for our creativity unit and arranging materials and resources that will be required during construction. Students have evaluated their market research and questionnaire feedback to aid them in the planning and designing of their products. This has helped them to make decisions in relation to colours, sizes and materials to be used as well as how many to make. All students at Mulbring PS are very excited that these will be for sale at school on the last day of Term 3.
